At Di Palo's in New York's Little Italy, customers sometimes arrive with a suitcase and fill it to the brim with cheeses, salamis and imported pasta. That's no longer necessary. Last month the 83-year-old institution launched a new Web site, **Di Palo Selects**. The site offers 37 types of cheese, including seven Italian pecorinos and Parmigiano-Reggianos made with fall or spring milk.
